Professor Pulse joined the Concordia Theological Seminary faculty in 2007. Following graduation from Concordia Teachers College in Seward, Nebraska, with a B.S. in Elementary Education, he attended Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, completing his M.Div. in 1984. His 22 years in the parish were served at St. John's Lutheran Church, Burt, Iowa, and Peace Lutheran, Bremerton, Washington. He completed his S.T.M. from Concordia Theological Seminary in 1990. Professor Pulse is currently a Ph.D. candidate at the University of Durham, England, in the area of Old Testament, specifically, Concepts of the Afterlife in the Old Testament and Second Temple Judaism.

No More "Peek-a-Boo Jesus": Christology of the Old Testament

Understanding the Old Testament and its Christological character and foundation means we must first understand the Hebrew people and their covenantal relationship with God. Therefore, the task is not to "find" Jesus in the Old Testament, but rather to recognize that Christ is the Old Testament. (1.5 CEU)
